- I. Call to Order; Roll Call
 - A. Nancy A. Michael called meeting to order at 7:05 P.M.
 - B. Deputy Clerk Treasurer Pam Pierce found all councilors to be present with the exception of Bob Sedlack.

The kick stands will be covered to protect the asphalt.
